

HEALTH AND DENTAL EXAMINATION FORMS

All health and dental forms are due no later than August 17, 2007*

State law and the Illinois State Board of Education require that the health and dental examination forms be completed *before a child is admitted to school*.

State law also requires that all students have the following examinations:

A complete physical examination

- kindergarten, 5th and 9th grades
- new to the United States

A complete dental examination

- kindergarten, 2nd and 6th grades

For students transferring from another United States school, a new physical may not be required. The health form from the previous school will be examined for State of Illinois compliance.

As a part of the examination record, the law requires evidence of the following immunizations:

- Rubeola (measles)
- Rubella (German measles)
- Tetanus/Pertussis (whooping cough)/Diphtheria
- Poliomyelitis
- Mumps
- Hepatitis B

Also required for children between the ages of 6 months and 6 years:

- Lead screening

Please Note: If your child had the measles vaccine **before** the age of 12 months, she/he should have two additional vaccinations. Your physician will advise if re-immunization is necessary. The exact date for all immunizations is required. *It is not acceptable to record "in infancy," "up-to-date" or only the year the vaccination was administered.* For example, the date of immunization should be recorded as follows: Rubella - 3/20/00.

The Skokie Health Department operates an immunization clinic for village residents. Vaccines are administered at no charge, but appointment only. The regular clinic hours are:

1:30 – 4:00 p.m., the second and fourth Wednesdays of every month

5:00 - 8:00 p.m. Wednesday evenings

9:00 a.m. and noon, Tuesday and Thursday
