Boys wear purple gowns and girls wear white gowns. No caps will be worn. The cost of these retainable gowns is \$18.00.

In order to insure proper fit you must complete the enclosed  
***Individual Measurement Form*** from Herff Jones

- Please complete the left hand side of the order form only.
- Be sure to include your child's last name, first name, middle initial, current height in feet and inches and weight, and to indicate your child's gender and first period (purple day) teacher's name.
- Measure your child's height while he or she is wearing shoes of similar heel height that will be worn for the graduation ceremony.
- Checks in the amount of \$18.00 should be made payable to SCHOOL DISTRICT 68
- Payment can be made by check or money order.
- **NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED!**

The completed form and check should be returned to your child's first period teacher no later than Friday, January 27th. Please return all three copies of the order form. If you need a receipt, please have your child request one from Ms. Johnson in the Main Office.

Students may wear the gown of an older sibling or other former OOH graduate. If your child plans to borrow a gown, it is important that he/she:

- 1.) inform Ms. Johnson in the Main Office by email at [sjohnson@skokie68.org](mailto:sjohnson@skokie68.org) or by written note from parent
- 2.) measure the length of the gown to make sure of proper fit.
