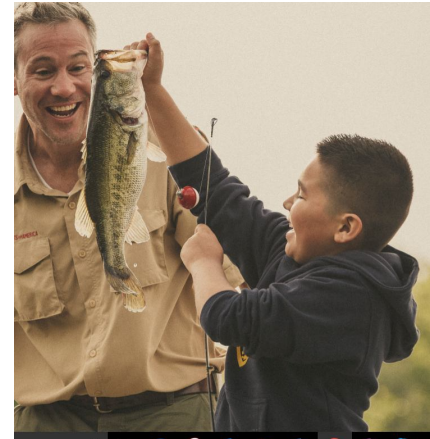


JOIN CUB SCOUTS AT STENSON!
