

Election Day is Nov. 7

Polls move from District 68 school buildings to alternate locations

Voters accustomed to going to the polls in District 68 schools should be aware that several polling places are changing for the fall election.

According to the Cook County Clerk's office, the following polling places will change for the upcoming election:

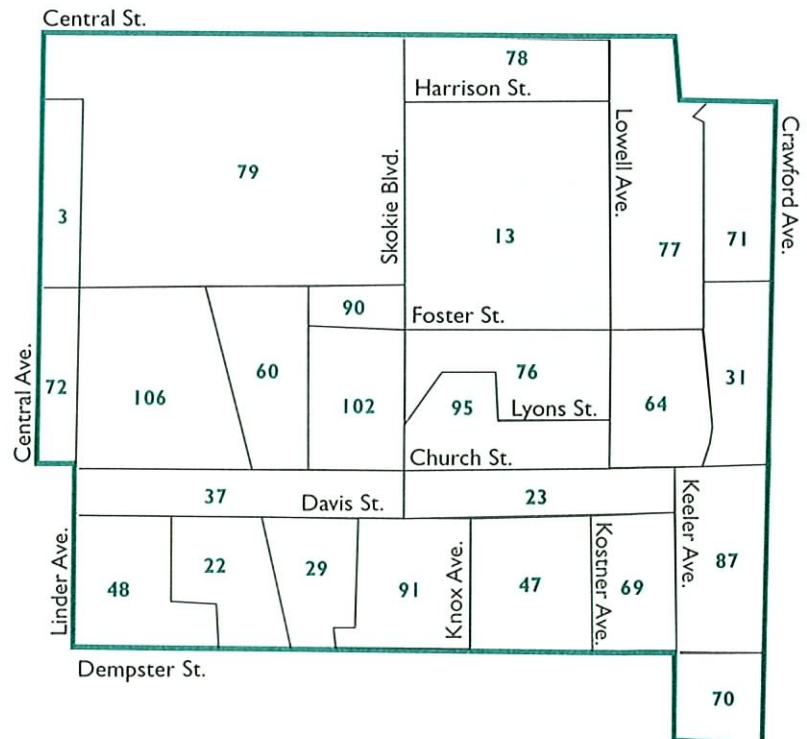
- Precincts 13 and 76 will move from Old Orchard Junior High School to the North Shore Center for the Performing Arts, 9501 Skokie Blvd.
- Precinct 23 will move from Old Orchard Junior High to the Devonshire Cultural Center, 4400 Greenwood Ave.
- Precinct 47 will move from Devonshire School to Ezra Habonim-Niles Township Jewish Congregation, 4500 Dempster St.
- Precinct 48 will move from Jane Stenson School to the Weber Leisure Center, 9300 Weber Park Pl.

Superintendent Frances McTague said the county clerk's office has been asking in recent years for schools that contain polling places to

close on election day. Rather than lose that day of school, district officials preferred that the polls be moved altogether, she said.

Illinois voters will go to the polls on Tuesday, Nov. 7. Polls are open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Early voting will take place from Oct. 16 through Nov. 2. Voters can determine the precinct in which they live by checking their voter registration cards or by contacting the county clerk's office.
