## In order to insure proper fit you must complete the enclosed Individual Measurement Form

- Please complete the enclosed order form.
- Be sure to include your child's current height in feet and inches and current weight
- Measure your child's height while he or she is wearing shoes of similar heel height that will be worn for the graduation ceremony.
- Payments should be made through your child's Infinite Campus Account.
- If you need to pay by check or money order please make payable to SCHOOL DISTRICT 68 in the amount of \$20.00.
- NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED!

The completed form and payment should be returned to Ms. Johnson in the Main Office no later than Friday, January 19, 2024. If you need a receipt, please have your child request one from Ms. Johnson in the Main Office.

Students may wear the gown of an older sibling or other former OOJH graduate. If your child plans to borrow a gown, it is important that he/she:

- 1.) inform Ms. Johnson in the Main Office by email at <a href="mailto:sjohnson@skokie68.org">sjohnson@skokie68.org</a> or by written note from parent
- 2.) measure the length of the gown to make sure of proper fit.
