Special 8th Grade Newsletter

As we approach the mid-point of the school year, we would like to take this opportunity to provide you with some important information and reminders about upcoming activities and events for 8th grade students and their families.

8th Grade Graduation Pictures – Thursday, January 18, 2024

All eighth grade students will have their graduation picture taken regardless of whether or not you intend to purchase pictures. Each family will receive a proof package approximately three to four weeks after picture day. The proofs will be sent home with your child. Pricing and online ordering information will accompany the proof package. There is no need to send money on picture day.

Each student will be dressed in an OOJH graduation gown, provided by the photographer for their individual picture and four poses will be taken. Two will be taken in dress clothes and two in the graduation gown. Please make sure that your eighth grade student is dressed appropriately for these pictures. Bulky sweaters, sweatshirts and turtlenecks should be avoided. Pictures will be taken throughout the school day and your student will be given a specific appointment time from their teachers.
